How do we manage sponsorships, donation or other contributions?

CelcomDigi has established a Sponsorship and Donation Committee (SDC) chaired by the Chief Corporate Affairs Officer (CCAO) and the Chief Home and Fibre (CH&F), together with the Heads of Compliance, Communications, Government Relations and Sustainability. The SDC is responsible for reviewing and approving non-commercial corporate sponsorships, donations and other contribution opportunities. The SDC shall maintain a high level of governance, transparency and consistency, as outlined in CelcomDigi's Code of Conduct, Anti-Corruption Policy and the Sponsorships and Donations Manual. Apart from the SDC, all requests shall also undergo a risk review, findings of which shall be presented at the Integrity Due Diligence (IDD) forum and the Governance Risk and Compliance (GRC) committee prior to final approval.
