Impact & Financial Assessment

Prioritizing employee well-being reduces accidents, absenteeism, and turnover. A safe work environment fosters a positive corporate culture, enhances productivity, and minimizes legal and financial risks.

Health and safety considerations have financial impact, but quantifying this impact differs among sectors. The exposure of telecoms workers to health and safety hazards is a significant concern due to the nature of their work, which often involves tasks such as working at height, dealing with structures that may collapse, and handling electricity. The financial implications depend on the severity of incidents and vary on a case-by-case basis. Potential financial impact includes medical expenses, compensation claims, potential legal actions, increased insurance premiums, and operational disruptions. Estimating the likelihood of health and safety incidents is challenging due to their unpredictable nature. However, implementing robust internal controls, maintaining rigorous safety practices, and cultivating a culture of safety awareness within the organization can effectively reduce the likelihood of such incidents. CelcomDigi is ISO45001 certified reducing the impact likelihood.
